New Shipston to Southam cycle route

A new cycle route between Shipston-on-Stour and Southam has been developed as part of The Vision for Shipston partnership between representatives of the town and Stratford District Council.

The route is a continuation of the route between Shipston-on-Stour and Moreton-in Marsh which was developed as a previous project of the partnership and is described in an accompanying leaflet which also includes information about the landscape through which the route passes and the heritage features along the way.

The whole of the route has been adopted by Sustrans the Bristol based developer of the National Cycle Network as the Warwickshire section of National Cycle Network Route 48 which runs cross country from the southwest to the northeast via National Cycle Network Route 41 between Leamington Spa and Rugby.
